Did You Know?

- The most unusual delivery method used by USPS is a mule train in Arizona. The mules carry mail, food and supplies down an 8mile trail to the Havasupai Indians at the bottom of the Grand Canyon.
- Franklin is the most common city name in the country with 31. Clinton and Washington are tied for second with 29 and Arlington • is at third with 28. The most common Post Office name is Clinton, with 26 locations, followed by Madison with 25 and Franklin and Washington tied for third with 24.
- The most common street name in the country is Main -- more than 13,000 of them -- followed by 2nd and Maple, with more than 8,000 each. The longest Main Street is in Island Park, ID, and is 33 miles long.
- The easiest to remember ZIP Code is 12345, a unique ZIP Code for General Electric in Schenectady, NY.
